

- Premature death measures the risk of dying before age 75.
- The result is a rate per 100,000 lives.
- Premature death is a relatively rare event in most communities and is an important measure of poor health.

Years of potential life lost due to premature death across Michigan is 7,500.

Black residents in Jackson County have a life expectancy <u>5 years shorter</u> than White residents.
